4 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §7054, sub-§1, ¶D,** as amended by PL 1993, c.
427, §1, is further amended to read:

6 D. "War, campaign or expedition" means any of the following
8 periods:

- 10 (1) April 6, 1917 to November 10, 1918;
12 (2) December 7, 1941 to September 1, 1945;
14 (3) June 27, 1950 to January 31, 1955;
16 (4) August 5, 1964 to May 7, 1975; and
18 (5) August 7, 1990 to ~~April-11~~ August 7, 1991.
