S	1754. Local review committee
£	Any person constructing a public improvement, public school acility or other building construction or other substantial
	enovation financed in whole or in part with public funds or
u	sing public loan guarantees is required to conduct a local
	<u>eview during the design phase of the construction or renovation</u>
	pon the written request of the governing body of the
	unicipality in which the facility is located. For the purposes
	f this section, "facility" means any public improvement, school acility or other building construciton or substantial renovation.
	1. Local review committee; established. Upon the written
ŗ	equest of a municipal governing body to the Director of the
	ureau of General Services, the director shall establish a local
r	eview committee.
	2. Local review committee; membership. The local review
C	ommittee consists of 5 members as follows:
	A. A member of the planning board, selected by the chair of
	the planning board of the municipality in which the facility
	is located;
	B. An elected official selected from the governing body of
	the municipality in which the facility is located;
	C. A user or potential user of the facility, to be chosen by the governing body of the municipality in which the
	facility is located;
	D. An employee of the state agency or department for which
	the facility is being constructed or renovated, chosen by
	the commissioner of that department; and
	E. One at-large member from the community in which the
	facility is located, chosen by the municipal governing body.
	3. Local review committee; responsibilities. The local
r	eview committee shall:
	A. Review the design of the facility and provide comments
	to the Director of the Bureau of General Services; and
	B. Request a public hearing, if desired by a majority of
	the local review committee members.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4. Department cooperation required. The Department of
Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of General Services
shall cooperate in the process of review by the local review
committee by providing access to the architect and the design of
the facility.
Sec. 2. 23 MRSA §73, sub-§3, ¶G, as corrected by RR 1991, c.
2, §88, is amended to read:
G. Incorporate a public participation process in accordance
with Title 5, section 1754 in which local governmental
bodies and the public have timely notice and opportunity to
identify and comment on concerns related to transportation
planning decisions, capital investment decisions and project
decisions. The department and the Maine Turnpike Authority
shall take the comments and concerns of local citizens into
account and must be responsive to them.
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STATEMENT OF FACT
This bill creates a local review committee that incorporates
a public participation process in which local governmental bodies
and the public have an opportunity to comment on certain public
improvements.
