SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 412, L.D. 569, Bill, "An Act to Remove Restrictions on Compensation For Deputy District Attorneys"

Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the relative limit on compensation for deputy district attorneys is set in statute. That limit has produced unacceptable inequities that can be corrected only with legislation; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, '


