Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §272, sub-§4, as amended by PL 1989, c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is further amended to read:

6 8 4. Deputy district attorney. Each district attorney may designate one full-time assistant district attorney or, if there is no full-time assistant district attorney, one part-time assistant district attorney to be the deputy district attorney. In the absence of the district attorney, the deputy shall act in the district attorney's place and shall-have has the authority, duties and responsibilities of the district attorney.
