**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

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**Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6751, sub-§2,** as amended by PL 1977, c. 713, §8, is further amended to read:

**2. Licensed activity.** ~~The A holder of a marine worm digger's license may fish for or take marine worms or possess, ship, transport or sell within the State those worms he the license holder has taken, except that a holder of a marine worm digger's license may not fish for or take marine worms or possess, ship, transport or sell worms the license holder has taken from intertidal areas closed by a municipality for conservation.~~

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This bill prohibits a holder of a marine worm digger's license from fishing for or taking marine worms or possessing, shipping, transporting or selling worms the license holder has taken from intertidal areas closed by a municipality for conservation.
