Notwithstanding section 1917, the Commissioner of Public Safety shall establish standards for retreaded truck tires that exceed federal specifications. The commissioner shall design the retreaded truck tire standards so as to lower the possibility of blowouts on highways and must ensure that those standards are stringently applied to all wheels in contact with the road in all truck inspections.

This bill requires the Commissioner of Public Safety to establish standards for retreaded truck tires that exceed federal standards and to ensure the application of those standards to all road contact tires in all truck inspections for the purpose of reducing truck tire blowouts.
