Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1888, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 814, $\S1$, is amended to read:

§1888. Review

The--department-may-net-accept-any-application-under-this chapter-after-June-30,-1995. By January 1, 1995, the Attorney General and the department shall submit recommendations, along with any necessary legislation, to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over human resources matters regarding whether this chapter should be amended.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the provision of the Hospital Cooperation Act of 1992 that prevents the acceptance of an application under the Act after June 30, 1995. The Act removes certain antitrust barriers to hospital cooperation.
