4	380, §2 and affected by §7, is further amended to read:
6	C. The proposed agency liquor store is not within $3-5$ 3 miles of an existing state liquor store or an existing
8	agency liquor store that was licensed before May 1, 1993.

14	This bill changes the distance allowed between sites of agency liquor stores from 3.5 miles to 2.5 miles.
