**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

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**Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §453, sub-§1, ¶C**, as amended by PL 1993, c.  
4 380, §2 and affected by §7, is further amended to read:

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C. The proposed agency liquor store is not within ~~3.5~~ 3  
8 miles of an existing state liquor store or an existing  
agency liquor store that was licensed before May 1, 1993.

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**STATEMENT OF FACT**

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This bill changes the distance allowed between sites of  
14 agency liquor stores from 3.5 miles to 2.5 miles.
