4	493, §6, is amended to read:
6	E-1. Stop and examine any all-terrain vehicle to ascertain whether it is being operated in compliance with chapter 715
8	subchapter IV, demand and inspect the operator's certificate of registration and, when appropriate, demand and inspect
10	evidence that the operator has satisfactorily completed a training course as required by section 7853; and
12	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7053, sub-§2, ¶F, as enacted by PL 1979, c
14	420, §1, is amended to read:
16	F. Stop and examine any snowmobile to ascertain whether is being operated in compliance with chapter 715, subchaptes
18	II; demand and inspect the operator's certificate of registration; and examine the identification numbers of the
20	snowmobile and any marks on it;-and.
