COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 427, L.D. 590, Bill, "An Act to Clarify Law Enforcement Relating to Junkyards and Automobile Graveyards"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §4452, sub-§5, ¶J, as amended by PL 1991, c. 548, Pt. D, §6, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

J. Laws pertaining to junkyards, automobile graveyards and automobile recycling businesses and local ordinances regarding junkyards, automobile graveyards and automobile recycling businesses, pursuant to chapter 183, subchapter I.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

**'FISCAL NOTE**

This bill may increase the number of civil violations filed in the court system. The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

The amendment replaces the original bill and removes reference to automobile salvage yards, which are covered elsewhere in the statutes. The amendment also adds automobile recycling businesses for consistency with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, chapter 183. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
