2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §133** is enacted to read:

6 **§133. Landowner Recognition Day**

8 The 3rd Saturday of September of each year is designated as  
10 Landowner Recognition Day and the Governor shall issue annually a  
12 proclamation inviting and urging the people of the State to  
14 observe this day in suitable places with appropriate activity.

16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

This bill establishes the Landowner Recognition Day on the  
3rd Saturday in September.
