An Act to Include More Information in the Report of the Board of Environmental Protection to the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §341-D, sub-§7, an enacted by PL 1989, c. 890, Pt. A, §13 and affected by §40, is amended to read:

6 7. Reports to the Legislature. The board shall report to thejoint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over energy and natural resource matters by January 8 15th of the first regular session of each Legislature on the effectiveness of the environmental laws of the State and any 10 recommendations for amending those laws or the laws governing the 12 board. The report must include a complete listing of all cases of violation of the department rules handled by the department during the previous year and must include a description and the 14 disposition of the violation and the name and address of the 16 violator.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires the Board of Environmental Protection to 22 include in the report that it files with the Legislature the number of cases of violation of the Department of Environmental 24 Protection rules handled, the type of violation, how the issue was resolved and who the violators were.
