14	HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 437, L.D. 603, Bill, "An Act to
16	Allow the Sale of Irradiated Food in the State"
18	Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:
20	'Sec. 3. Statutory referendum procedure; submission at statewide election; form of question; effective date. This Act must be submitted
22	to the legal voters of the State of Maine at a statewide election held on the Tuesday following the first Monday of November
24	following passage of this Act. The municipal officers of this State shall notify the inhabitants of their respective cities,
26	towns and plantations to meet, in the manner prescribed by law for holding a statewide election, to vote on the acceptance or
28	rejection of this Act by voting on the following question:
30	"Do you favor allowing the sale of irradiated food in the State?"
32	The legal voters of each city, town and plantation shall
34	vote by ballot on this question, and shall designate their choice by a cross or check mark placed within a corresponding square
36	below the word "Yes" or "No." The ballots must be received, sorted, counted and declared in open ward, town and plantation
38	meetings and returns made to the Secretary of State in the same manner as votes for members of the Legislature. The Governor
40	shall review the returns and, if it appears that a majority of the legal votes are cast in favor of the Act, the Governor shall
42	proclaim that fact without delay, and the Act takes effect 30 days after the date of the proclamation.
