2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §5403** is enacted to read:

6 **§5403. Transportation; private school students**

8 A school administrative district shall provide to students
10 residing in the district and attending approved private schools
12 the same transportation privileges within the district as are
14 provided to students attending the district's public schools.

16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

18 This bill requires that private school students be accorded
the same transportation privileges within a town or combined
school district that public school students receive.
