SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 465, L.D. 631, Bill, "An Act to Increase Access to the Legislature and Government Services for Persons Who Are Deaf or Hard of Hearing and to Make Progress towards Compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first indented paragraph after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in the 6th line from the end (page 3, line 30 in amendment) by striking out the following: "systems and" and inserting in its place the following: 'systems,'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in the 5th line from the end (page 3, line 31 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "rooms" the following: 'and the provision of interpreting services for legislative business'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 4 and 5.

Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 5 the following:

'Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.'

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment eliminates the need for General Fund appropriations to the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment eliminates the requirements that the Legislature employ session-only interpreters and install large-area listening systems. The amendment also strikes the appropriation section and adds a fiscal note.
