SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 240, L.D. 637, Bill, "An Act to Change the Commissions Payable to the State from Off-track Betting"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~\$275-0.~~" in subsection 3 by striking out all of paragraph C (page 2, line 19 in amendment) and relettering paragraphs D and E to be paragraphs C and D.

**FISCAL NOTE**

This amendment eliminates the loss of General Fund revenue. The reductions of dedicated revenues to the various funds will begin in fiscal year 1994-95 as a result of the bill being implemented sooner. The amounts of the additional reductions of dedicated revenues in fiscal year 1994-95 can not be determined at this time.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment removes payments to the General Fund from the list of payments reduced by the reduced payment formula.
