be reduced by \$98,049 and \$96,706 in fiscal years 1995-96 and
1996-97, respectively. The Bureau of Motor Vehicles will realize savings of approximately these same amounts. Current services
allocations may be adjusted to reflect these savings.

The delay will likely result in the contractor bringing suit against the State for monetary losses incurred as a result of the repeal. If the plaintiff is successful, additional funding for the recovery will be necessary. The amount and timing of the funding will depend on when the suit is filed and its outcome.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment defers the vehicle registration requirement 16 until June 30, 2005.
