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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 250, L.D. 647, Bill, "An  
Act to Amend the Laws Regarding Use and Acquisition of State  
Property"

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Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "S20-A."  
in subsection 3 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 2,  
lines 2 to 5 in L.D.).

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Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated  
"S20-A." by striking out all of subsection 4.

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**STATEMENT OF FACT**

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This amendment retains the provision in the original bill  
that allows the State to seek an action for injunctive relief,  
which does not prohibit the State from also seeking criminal  
sanctions if the State desires to do so.
