Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6954-B is enacted to read:
§6954-B. Dragging prohibited in portions of the St. Croix River
It is unlawful for any person to operate a vessel towing a
drag or trawl for the purpose of harvesting groundfish or
shellfish in coastal waters between the Route 1 bridge across the
St. Croix River in the Town of Calais and a line running due east
from the Robbinston fish factory in the Town of Robbinston.
STATEMENT OF FACT
This bill prohibits the use of drags in that portion of the
St. Croix River that lies between the Route 1 bridge over that
river in Calais and the Robbinston fish factory in the Town of

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Robbinston.
