	This bill incorporates the requirements of the Maine Revised
16	Statutes, Title 32, section 13907 into the laws governing municipal review of proposed subdivisions to ensure that
18	municipal reviewing authorities do not accept or approve any plan or document that lacks a required seal and signature of a
20	professional land surveyor.

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
