

**An Act to Allow Nonresidents to Transport into the State Liquor  
Purchased in New Hampshire.**

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §2075, sub-§1, ¶A,** as amended by PL 1993, c.  
730, §47, is further amended to read:

6 A. ~~An individual~~ A resident may transport into the State  
8 and may transport from place to place within the State  
spirits for the ~~individual's~~ resident's personal use in a  
10 quantity not greater than 4 quarts.

12 **Sec. 2. 28-A MRSA §2075, sub-§1, ¶B** is enacted to read:

14 B. A nonresident may transport into the State and may  
transport from place to place within the State less than 10  
gallons of spirits for the nonresident's personal use if  
16 those spirits were purchased in a New Hampshire liquor store.

18 **Sec. 3. 28-A MRSA §2075, sub-§2,** as amended by PL 1993, c.  
20 730, §47, is further amended to read:

22 **2. Transportation of spirits within the State.** ~~No~~ Except  
as provided in subsection 1, a person may not transport or cause  
24 to be transported any spirits within the State in a quantity  
greater than 4 quarts unless the spirits were purchased from a  
state or agency liquor store.

26 **Sec. 4. 28-A MRSA §2077, sub-§1,** as amended by PL 1993, c.  
28 730, §49, is further amended to read:

30 **1. Importation of malt liquor or wine into the State.** No  
32 person other than a wholesale licensee, small brewery licensee or  
farm winery licensee may transport or cause to be transported  
malt liquor or wine into the State in a quantity greater than 3  
34 gallons for malt liquor and 4 quarts for wine, unless it was  
legally purchased in the State, except that a nonresident may  
36 transport less than 10 gallons of malt liquor or wine if it was  
purchased in a New Hampshire liquor store.

38 A. All shipments of malt liquor or wine transported or  
40 caused to be transported by wholesale licensees, small  
brewery licensees or farm winery licensees into the State  
42 must be accompanied by an invoice, including the wholesale  
licensee's, small brewery licensee's or farm winery  
44 licensee's name and purchase number.
