Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 **Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §3308, sub-§7, ¶D** is enacted to read:

6 D. Nothing in this section precludes dissemination of the
8 information described in paragraph B, concerning a specific
10 juvenile, by a criminal justice agency to the administrator
12 of a public housing project for further dissemination to the
14 residents of the public housing project when that juvenile
16 moves into or resides in the public housing project.

14 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

16 This bill authorizes a criminal justice agency to release
18 certain juvenile offense information to a public housing
20 administrator for the administrator to share with the other
22 residents of the public housing project when a juvenile with a
 juvenile offense record moves into or lives in the public housing
 project. The records pertain to serious or multiple juvenile
 offenses, offenses committed with the use of a weapon and
 offenses for which the juvenile was tried as an adult.
