	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §354, sub-§8-A, as enacted by PL 1985, c.
4	383, §8, is amended to read:
6	8-A. Filed with the Secretary of State. A nomination petition except for independent presidential candidates must be
8	filed in the office of the Secretary of State by 5 p.m. on the date of the primary election in the election year in which it is
10	to be used.
12	A nomination petition for an independent presidential candidate must be filed in the office of the Secretary of State by 5 p.m.
14	on August 1st in the election year in which it is to be used.
16	STATEMENT OF FACT

20	This bill requires the nomination petition for an independent presidential candidate to be filed by August 1st of the year of the election.
