Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

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Deappropriates funds to reflect a 15% reduction in the Legislative budget. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585 or any other provision of law, the deappropriation must be distributed by financial order among the various programs by the Executive Director of the Legislative Council based on the recommendation of the Legislative Council.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill provides for an annual 15% reduction in the Legislature's budget.

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
