COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 505, L.D. 686, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit the Employment of Professional Strikebreakers"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill eliminates a Class E crime. If the number of jail sentences is reduced, the savings to the counties are estimated to be \$83.22 per day for each offender. Costs to the counties for Class E crimes are not reimbursed by the State. The amount of any reductions of jail time and the resulting savings to the county jail system are expected to be insignificant.

This bill also establishes a new civil violation. The resulting net effect on the workload and administrative costs of the Judicial Department and General Fund revenue from fines is also expected to be insignificant.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
