An Act to Amend the Law Regulating 53-foot Semitrailers.

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2390, sub-§1, ¶J, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 4 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read: 6 Notwithstanding any other provision of this subsection, a single semitrailer whose total length exceeds 48 feet but 8 does not exceed 53 feet may be operated in combination with a truck tractor en-highways-designated-by-the-Commissioner 10 of-Transportation if the following conditions are met. 12 The wheelbase of the semitrailer, measured as the distance from the kingpin to the center of the rearmost axle of the semitrailer, may not exceed 43 feet. 14 16 The kingpin setback of the semitrailer, measured as the distance from the kingpin to the front of the 18 semitrailer, may not exceed 3 1/2 feet in length. 20 The rear overhang of the semitrailer, measured as the distance from the center of the rear tandem axles 22 of the semitrailer to the rear of the semitrailer, may not exceed 35% of the wheelbase of the semitrailer. 24 The semitrailer must be equipped with a rear underride guard that is of sufficient strength to 26 prevent a motor vehicle from penetrating underneath the 28 semitrailer, extends across the rear of the semitrailer to within an average distance of 4 inches of the lateral extremities of the semitrailer, exclusive of 30 safety bumper appurtenances, and is placed at a height 32 not exceeding 22 inches from the surface of the ground as measured when the semitrailer is empty and is on a 34 level surface. The semitrailer must be equipped with vehicle 36 lights that comply with or exceed federal standards and 38 reflective material approved by the Commissioner of Transportation that must be located on the semitrailer 40 a manner prescribed by the commissioner. semitrailer must display a conspicuous warning on the rear of the semitrailer indicating that the vehicle 42 combination has a wide turning radius. 44 The semitrailer and the truck tractor used in (6) 46 combination with the semitrailer may not have liftable 48 (7) The maximum gross weight of the truck tractor and
