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## STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This amendment restricts purchase of retirement service credits provided in the original bill to members of the Maine 18 State Retirement System who were formerly Peace Corps workers. The amendment requires payment for the service credit purchased 20 at the same rate as for purchase of prior armed forces service credits under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 17713, 22 subsection 2, paragraph A.

The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
