HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 516, L.D. 706, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1996 and June 30, 1997"

Amend the amendment in Part LL in section 2 in subsection 2 in the 2nd line (page 399, line 23 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "charges." the following: 'Effective September 1, 1995, room and board costs are the responsibility of the student or the student's family.'

Further amend the amendment in Part LL in section 2 in subsection 2 in paragraph B in the 2nd line (page 399, line 41 in amendment) by striking out the following: "July 1, 1996" and inserting in its place the following: 'September 1, 1995'

Further amend the amendment in Part LL in section 2 in subsection 2 in paragraph C in the first line (page 400, line 4 in amendment) by striking out the following: "July 1, 1996," and inserting in its place the following: 'September 1, 1995,'

Further amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

**Sec. III-1. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.
