HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 516, L.D. 706, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1996 and June 30, 1997"

Amend the amendment in Part VV in section 1 in that part designated "§5111-B." in subsection 2 in the 6th line from the end (page 413, line 43 in amendment) by striking out the following: "taxable" and inserting in its place the following: 'adjusted gross'

Further amend the amendment in Part VV in section 1 in that part designated "§5111-B." in subsection 2 in the 4th line from the end (page 413, line 45 in amendment) by striking out the following: "taxable" and inserting in its place the following: 'adjusted gross'

Further amend the amendment in Part VV in section 1 in that part designated "§5111-B." in subsection 2 in the 2nd line from the end (page 413, line 47 in amendment) by striking out the following: "taxable" and inserting in its place the following: 'adjusted gross'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.


