SENATE AMENDMENT " D " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 516, L.D. 706, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1996 and June 30, 1997"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of Part VV.


Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

There is no net effect on General Fund appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained for fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the section on revenue targeting, which makes certain tax rates unadjustable.
