**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

**Whereas**, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

**Whereas,** certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of the Department of Defense and Veterans' Services will become due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1995; and

**Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

## **Sec. 1. Allocation of Maine Nuclear Emergency Planning Fund.**

Income to the Maine Nuclear Emergency Planning Fund for the next 2 fiscal years, from July 1, 1995 to June 30, 1996 and from July 1, 1996 to June 30, 1997 must be segregated, apportioned and disbursed as designated in the following schedule:
