An Act to Make Allocations from the Public Advocate Regulatory Fund for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1996 and June 30, 1997.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of the Office of the Public Advocate will become due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1995; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §116, sub-§8, as amended by PL 1993, c. 633, §§1 and 2 and affected by §3, is further amended by amending the first paragraph to read:
- 24 Public Advocate assessment. Every utility subject to assessment under this section is subject to an additional annual assessment on its intrastate gross operating revenues to produce 26 \$557,307 <u>\$617,680</u> in revenues for fiscal year 1993-94 <u>1995-96</u> and 28 \$571,615 <u>\$625,781</u> in fiscal year 1994-95 <u>1996-97</u> for operating the Office of Public Advocate. The revenues produced from this 3.0 assessment are transferred to the Public Advocate Regulatory Fund and may only be used to fulfill the duties specified in chapter 32 The assessments charged to utilities under this subsection considered just and reasonable operating costs rate-making purposes. The Public Advocate shall develop a method 34 accounting for staff time within the Office of Public 36 Advocate. All professional and support staff shall account for their time in such a way as to identify the percentage of time devoted to public utility regulation and the percentage of time 38 devoted to other duties that may be required by law.
