An Act to Allow All Hunters to Hunt Deer on the 5th Saturday Preceding Thanksgiving.

6		A. Except as otherwise provided in this section or by rule adopted by the commissioner pursuant to this section, there
8		is an open season on deer in each calendar year in all counties of the State from the 5th Menday Saturday preceding
10		Thanksgiving to November 30th. In any year when November 30th falls on a Wednesday, Thursday or Friday, the
12		commissioner may, by rule, extend the open season on deer to the first Saturday in December. In any year in which the
14		commissioner extends the season beyond November 30th, the commissioner shall by rule open the season in the northern
16		portion of the State a week before opening the season in the southern portion of the State. The commissioner may by rule
18		establish for this purpose a northern and a southern zone.
