Be it	enacted	by th	e People	of the	State of	Maine	as follows:
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Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §4741, sub-§15, as amended by PL 1991, c. 871, §2, is further amended to read:

State weatherization, conservation and fuel assistance The Maine State Housing Authority is designated the weatherization, energy conservation and fuel assistance agency for the State and may apply for, receive, distribute and administer federal funds of on behalf the State weatherization, energy conservation and fuel assistance pursuant to the Weatherization Assistance for Low-income Persons Program administered through the United States Department of Energy and the Low-income Home Energy Assistance Program administered through the United States Department of Health and Human Services in accordance with rules adopted under the Maine Administrative Procedure Act+.

A. Local agencies designated by the Maine State Housing Authority as subgrantees for the purposes of administering the federal Low-income Home Energy Assistance Program must meet the following program and fiscal requirements.

(1) Local agencies must be able to administer the program at the lowest cost per applicant in the area that the local agency serves. The authority shall determine whether this requirement is met based on a competitive bidding procedure. The authority may designate as subgrantees local agencies that serve overlapping areas, provided each subgrantee is the lowest bidder for at least some portion of the area it serves;

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires the Maine State Housing Authority to designate local agencies as subgrantees under the federal Low-income Home Energy Assistance Program based on a competitive bidding process.
