COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 530, L.D. 726, Bill, "An Act to Allow Employees of the Maine State Liquor and Lottery Commission and Their Families to Purchase Lottery Tickets"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Allow Certain Employees of the Maine State Liquor and Lottery Commission and Their Families to Purchase Lottery Tickets'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §381, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 505, §2, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

§381. Persons prohibited from purchasing tickets or shares

A ticket or share may not be purchased by and a prize may not be paid to any of the following persons:

1. Commission officers. An officer of the commission;

2. Senior supervisory personnel. Senior supervisory employees of the commission, as determined by the commission officers; and

3. Household member. Any spouse, child, brother, sister, parent or person residing as a member of the same household in the principal place of abode of any of the persons identified in subsections 1 and 2.'

2 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

4 **FISCAL NOTE**

6 Allowing certain state employees and their families to buy
lottery tickets will result in insignificant increases of General
8 Fund revenue from increased lottery ticket sales.'

10 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 This amendment replaces the bill, which repealed the section
of law that prohibited all employees of the Maine State Liquor
and Lottery Commission and the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and
16 Lottery Operations, and their families, from purchasing lottery
tickets. This amendment retains the prohibition for commission
18 officers, senior supervisory employees of the commission and
members of the households of these 2 groups. It also adds a
20 fiscal note to the bill.
