## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the bill, which repealed the section of law that prohibited all employees of the Maine State Liquor and Lottery Commission and the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations, and their families, from purchasing lottery tickets. This amendment retains the prohibition for commission officers, senior supervisory employees of the commission and members of the households of these 2 groups. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
