	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7857, sub-§16, ¶C, as amended by PL 1989, c. 913, Pt. B, §14, is further amended to read:
4	915, PC. B, 914, IS further amended to read:
6	C. Every new ATV, except 2-wheel off-road motorcycles, manufactured after January 1, 1991, and sold in Maine, must
8	be equipped with working headlights, <u>and</u> taillights and brake-lights.
10	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7857, sub-§24, ¶G, as enacted by PL 1993, c.
12	26, $\$1$, is amended to read:
14	G. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 16, a person may operate an ATV without a headlight, <u>and</u> taillight
16	and-brake-light between the hours of sunrise and sunset, provided:
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20	(1) The ATV has an engine size of 90 cubic centimeters or less;
22	(2) Has 4 or more wheels; and
24	(3) The American National Standards for Four-Wheel All-Terrain Vehicles, Equipment, Configuration, and
26	Performance Requirements proscribed equipping the vehicle at the time of manufacture with the lighting
28	equipment specified in subsection 16, paragraphs A, B and C.
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32	STATEMENT OF FACT
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36	This bill removes the requirement that all-terrain vehicles be equipped with brake lights.

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
