'FISCAL NOTE

The additional costs associated with periodically 24 renominating certain gubernatorial appointments can be absorbed by the Executive Department utilizing existing budgeted resources. 26

The Legislature will incur some minor additional costs to hold confirmation hearings. These costs can be absorbed within the Legislature's existing budgeted resources.' 30

STATEMENT OF FACT

34 This amendment replaces the bill and specifies that renomination and reconfirmation apply only to commissioners and 36 the Director of the State Planning Office. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
