An Act to Require the Reconfirmation of Gubernatorial Appointments at the Beginning of Each Gubernatorial Term.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §154, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 685, 4 Pt. A, §4, is amended to read:

6 The Governor shall, within 20 days after the convening of each legislative session, provide to each joint standing 8 committee of the Legislature a list of all positions for which legislative confirmation is required that are within each 10 committee's jurisdiction and that are vacant or have terms expiring before the convening of the next regular session of the 12 Legislature. At the beginning of the term of a newly elected or reelected Governor, all persons in positions for which 14 legislative confirmation is required must be nominated by the Governor and reconfirmed by the Legislature. The chairs of each 16 joint standing committee and the Governor, or their designees, shall negotiate in good faith to establish a schedule for nominations and consideration of nominations during the session. 18

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that all gubernatorial appointments go 24 through the confirmation process at the beginning of each gubernatorial term.
