This bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$25,647 and \$37,464 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively, for a Correctional Caseworker position at the Maine Youth Center.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice. The amendment changes the amount to be allocated for fiscal year 1995-96 from \$34,195 to \$25,647 and also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
