Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §511-A is enacted to read:

<u>§511-A. Registration possession</u>

Notwithstanding section 404, subsection 1, a business that8holds current registrations on any combination of trailers or
semitrailers totaling 4 or more may keep the original10certificates of registration in a central location. If the
certificates of registration are kept in a central location, the12business must ensure that, for each vehicle, a photocopy of the
vehicle's certificate of registration is kept in some easily14accessible place in the vehicle.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits businesses that hold current certificates of registration on 4 or more trailers or semitrailers to keep the original certificates in a central location. It also requires that businesses that use this provision keep a photocopy of the certificate of registration in each vehicle.
