HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 550, L.D. 746, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Law Relating to Municipal Service Fees and to Modify the Reimbursement Policy for Hospitals to Recover Service Fees Paid"

Amend the amendment in section 7 by striking out all of the 2nd sentence (page 3, lines 37 to 39 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'Other members are not entitled to reimbursement for expenses.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 8 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 8. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
