COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 281, L.D. 753, Bill, "An Act to Correct and Clarify Certain Provisions of the Liquor Laws"

Amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "~~\$161-B.~~" in subsection 2 in the 10th line (page 2, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "6" and inserting in its place the following: '3'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 4.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment reduces from 6 to 3 the number of consecutive days a public hearing on the applicant's request to operate a bottle club must be advertised. It also removes the section of the bill that would have eliminated local authority over bottle club applications. The result is that municipal authority over bottle club applications is retained.
