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	Sec. 3. Exclusion. Notwithstanding the provisions of sections
2	1 and 2 of this Act, up to \$750,000 for Capital Expenditures may
	be expended in each fiscal year of the biennium, exclusive of
4	capital items obtained through lease-purchases or other similar
	agreements consistent with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5,
6	section 1587 and other applicable laws. It is the intent of the
	Legislature that no capital items purchased through the
8	Intergovernmental Telecommunications Fund may be given,
	transferred, sold or otherwise conveyed to any other department,
10	agency or account, unless the transaction has received specific
	prior legislative authorization through the budgetary process.

	Sec. 4. Encumbered balance at year-end. At the end of each
14	fiscal year, all encumbered balances may not be carried more than
	once.

	Sec. 5. Legislative intent. It is the intent of the Legislature
18	that all departments and agencies be assessed telecommunication
	charges on the basis of uniform billing procedures and in direct
20	proportion to the services they are provided. However, during
	fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, no department or agency may be
22	required to utilize resources in excess of levels that have
	historically been found to be necessary and available to it in
24	order to maintain the level of service currently being received
