	32	This bill may increase prosecutions for theft, which may be a Class B, C, D or E crime, depending on the amount involved.
	34	The resulting increase in costs to the State and county correctional institutions can not be estimated at this time.
	36	The Judicial Department may require additional General Fund
	38	appropriations to cover indigent defense costs related to these new cases. The amounts can not be estimated at this time. The
