2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §651, sub-§4**, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683,
Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

6 **4. Certificate of salvage.** The Secretary of State may
8 issue a certificate of salvage upon surrender of a certificate of
title and evidence that a vehicle was declared a total loss by an
10 owner or an insurance company. The Secretary of State may issue
a certificate of salvage without receipt of a certificate of
title if the vehicle is 10 years old or older and the vehicle has
12 been inspected in accordance with section 657, subsection 6.

16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

18 This bill allows the Secretary of State to issue a
20 certificate of salvage without receiving a certificate of title
when the vehicle is 10 years old or older and the vehicle has
22 been inspected to determine that the vehicle conforms with the
description on the application.
