Resolved: That the Department of Marine Resources shall conduct a study concerning the sea cucumber industry. This study must include an evaluation of the costs and benefits to the sea cucumber industry and to the people of the State of establishing a licensing provision and imposing restrictions on the harvest season, use of gear and any other factor important to this industry. The department shall submit its report, together with recommendations and any necessary implementing legislation, to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council for distribution to the Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources no later than December 31, 1995.
