Sec. 2. Transfer of allocation. Any balance of an allocation or 22 subdivision of an allocation made by the Legislature for the 24 Maine Turnpike Authority that at any time is not required for the purpose named in the allocation or subdivision may be transferred 26 at any time prior to the closing of the books to any other allocation or subdivision of any allocation made by the 28 Legislature for the use of the Maine Turnpike Authority for the same fiscal year subject to review by the joint standing 30 committee of Legislature having jurisdiction the over Financial transportation matters. statements describing the32 transfer must be submitted to the Maine Turnpike Authority to the Office of Fiscal and Program Review 30 days before the transfer 34 is to be implemented. In case of an extraordinary emergency transfer, the 30-day prior submission requirement may be waived by vote of the committee. These financial statements must 36 include information specifying the accounts that are affected, 38 amounts to be transferred, a description of the transfer and a detailed explanation as to why the transfer is needed.

Sec. 3. Encumbered balance at year end. At the end of each fiscal year, encumbered balances may be carried to the next fiscal year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill makes allocations from the gross revenues of the Maine Turnpike Authority for the authority's fiscal year ending December 31, 1996, in accordance with the requirements of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23, section 1961, subsection 6 and the authority's general bond resolution.

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
