Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §12706, sub-§13, as amended by PL 1991, c. 246, §10, is further amended to read:

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The Maine Technical College System is required by state law to seek legislative approval for the transfer of interests in property, which includes the granting of utility easements. This bill gives authority to the Board of Trustees of the Maine Technical College System to grant utility easements.
